- 3. Within 10 days of the date of this order, Kentucky RSA #3 Cellular General Partnership shall provide answers to the questions set forth in Ms. Biggs' motion for intervention. Kentucky RSA #3 shall send to Ms. Biggs a copy of the answers filed with the Commission.
