ORDER

On December 13, 1990, Black Mountain Utility District ("Black Mountain") filed revised tariff sheets with the Commission proposing to increase its meter-connection fee to \$400. Black Mountain also requested a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10(1)(b-e) and (2), which was denied by Order of the Commission dated January 11, 1991. In that Order, the Commission also suspended Black Mountain's tariff filing for five months up to and including June 12, 1991, and noted that it had previously informed Black Mountain of certain filing deficiencies.

On January 28, 1991, the Commission again notified Black Mountain by letter that if the information necessary to cure the filing deficiencies was not received within five days, Staff would recommend to the Commission that this proceeding be dismissed.

On February 5, 1991, the Commission received a letter from Black Mountain requesting an extension of time of unspecified duration to submit the information. By letter dated February 6, 1991, the Commission granted an extension of time until February 13, 1991.

Having reviewed the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that, as of the date of this Order, Black Mountain has not filed the required information.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this proceeding be and it hereby is dismissed without prejudice to Black Mountain to file again at a later date.
