ORDER

On February 5, 1991, PacTel Paging of Kentucky, Inc. ("PacTel") filed an application to discontinue its two-way mobile utility service in Louisville, Crestwood, Frankfort, Lexington, and Clay's Ferry. PacTel states that its mobile utility service in these locations has operated at a significant loss and will likely continue to do so because of competition from other mobile service providers and cellular telephone providers. Further, PacTel states that its subscribers, numbering less than 20, have been notified of the pending discontinuance of service.

Having considered this application and having been otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY GRANTS PacTel's application for discontinuance of service pursuant to KRS 278.020(4). PacTel may abandon its service at Louisville, Crestwood, Frankfort, Lexington, and Clay's Ferry. Revised tariff pages 7 and 9 are hereby approved, effective February 26, 1991.
