## ORDE\_R

IT IS ORDERED that U.S. Long Distance, Inc. ("USLD") shall file the original and ten copies of the following with the Commission within 10 days from the date of this Order.

1. Refer to Original Sheet 9.1, Items 8 and 9 of the proposed tariff. The Commission's March 27, 1991 Order in Administrative Case No.  $330^1$  states at page 10: "Carriers are not permitted to include any other surcharges. . . ." Provide a revised tariff sheet deleting Items 8 and 9.

2. Refer to Sections 2.9(2) and 4.1.1.A of the proposed tariff sheets filed on March 20, 1991. Merge these two sections into one section.

3. Refer to Section 2.9(2) and 4.1.1.A of the proposed tariff. The rate provided is not in compliance with the Administrative Case No. 330 Orders. Furthermore, it does not include rates for other types of services. Provide a revised

Administrative Case No. 330, Policy and Procedures in the Provision of Operator-Assisted Telecommunications Services.

tariff sheet which includes rates for collect station to station, station to station, person to person, collect person to person, customer dialed credit card. These rates shall be in compliance with the Administrative Case No. 330 Orders.

4. Refer to Section 2.9 of the proposed tariff. This section refers to Section 3.4.7, however there is no such section. Clarify.

5. Refer to Section 4.1.1 of the proposed tariff. This address clearly the section shall Ъe revised to blocking/interception prohibition requirements to both competing carriers' operators and local exchange companies' operators. Furthermore, it shall have the clear language regarding the violation of these provisions and tent card/sticker display. Provide a revised tariff sheet in complete compliance with ordering paragraphs 3(c), 3(d), and 3(f) of the March 27, 1991 Order in Administrative Case No. 330.

6. Refer to Original Sheets 11, 12 and 13 of the proposed tariff filed with the application. The requirements of Administrative Case No. 330 are applicable to all non-local exchange carrier operator services. Provide revised tariff sheets clarifying that these restrictions apply uniformly to all operator-assisted services.

7. Refer to Original Sheet 13 of the proposed tariff. Section 4.1.3 references Section 3.4.7.A which is not included in the proposed tariff. Reconcile and provide appropriate revisions to the tariff.

8. Provide revised tariff sheets which include the rates for holidays, evening, night in accordance with the Administrative Case No. 330 Orders.

9. With reference to the financial requirements of Administrative Case No. 273,<sup>2</sup> provide the following information:

a. Provide a current (within 90 days of filing) income statement.

b. Provide pro forma Kentucky operating statements, including the company's potential or forecasted demand and operations for its first 2 years of service.

c. At USLD's option, in lieu of a and b, provide a showing of sufficient cash reserves or other financial backing to sustain USLD through its initial 2 year operating period.

10. In its application, USLD makes reference to Exhibit "F." All exhibits are unlabeled, and no sequence of pages appears to correspond to Exhibit "F."

a. Identify the pages intended to represent Exhibit
"F."

b. If Exhibit "F" was omitted from the application, provide a copy of this exhibit.
