O R D E R

The Commission, based on a review of the pleadings, hereby finds that Clark Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, Inc. ("Clark RECC") accepts all the material facts contained in the Complaint, but denies that any relief is due under Clark RECC's tariff or Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:041, Section 11. The Commission notes that Clark RECC's current tariff governing distribution line extensions to non-residential structures has been in effect since November 28, 1982. Although that tariff was filed with, and accepted by, the Commission, it has never been approved by an Order of the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. A hearing be and it hereby is scheduled for June 27, 1991, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room No. 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky, for the purposes of receiving testimony and cross-

examination of witnesses for the Complainant and Clark RECC, and to receive oral argument.

2. Clark RECC shall present evidence at the hearing to support the reasonableness of its tariff governing distribution line extensions to non-residential structures.
