O R D E R

The Commission, having reviewed Kentucky Utilities Company's ("KU") responses to Items 3a and 4 of the July 19, 1991 Order, hereby finds that KU has misinterpreted the request.

The request did not include the PROSCREEN II program, database formats or input file commands, but was limited to the workpapers which provide the detailed support for the present value revenue requirements for each of the plans contained in sets A, B and C. If the 3 inches of computer printout referenced in KU's response contains a summary of the information supporting the present value revenue requirements, that summary with an appropriate explanation should be provided. If this information is only available in a form that KU claims is confidential, the information must be provided pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, with a petition for confidentiality.

The Commission further finds that due to the complex and voluminous nature of the computer programs and printouts supporting KU's application, an informal conference should be scheduled at a mutually convenient time at KU's offices for KU to make a presentation by personnel with expertise in this area.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KU shall respond to Items 3a and 4 of the Commission's July 19, 1991 Order, as clarified above, within seven days of the date of this Order.

2. KU shall, within seven days of the date of this Order, advise the Commission and all parties in writing of available dates during August 1991 for the informal conference.
