O R D E R

This matter arises upon the June 7, 1991 filing by Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. ("Columbia") of a supplemental complaint and a motion for an order to cease in the above-referenced proceeding, and it appearing to the Commission that good cause exists to expedite its review of the pending complaint,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The Respondent, Kentucky-Ohio Gas Company ("Kentucky-Ohio"), shall have 7 days from the date of this Order within which to supplement its answer to the complaint and file its response to the motion for an order to cease.

2. Columbia and Kentucky-Ohio shall each have 21 days from the date of this Order within which to conduct discovery regarding the matters complained of, said discovery periods to run concurrently. Each party shall file any interrogatories upon the other party within 10 days of the date of this Order with the responses due within 21 days from the date of this Order. All

discovery requests and responses shall be filed with the Commission.

3. Respondent and Petitioner shall appear at a public hearing scheduled for July 12, 1991, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky. The parties shall appear prepared to produce witnesses and documentary evidence regarding allegations of physical bypass of Columbia's distribution system.
