O R D E R

By application received May 16, 1991, Boonesboro Water Association ("Boonesboro Water") requested a permanent deviation from Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 5(4), which provides that each utility shall provide water storage to ensure a minimum of one day's supply of its average daily water usage. Boonesboro Water states in its application that its average daily water usage, including unaccounted-for water, is approximately 343,944 gallons, and that its current water storage capacity is 224,740 gallons. Boonesboro Water's application also states that its supplier, Winchester Municipal Utilities ("WMU"), has a total of 3.5 million gallons of storage.

Boonesboro filed a letter with its application from WMU which states that WMU's average daily demand is 2.7 million gallons. This same letter also states that Boonesboro Water's average daily demand is included as part of WMU's average daily demand and is counted as part of WMU's water storage requirements.

Boonesboro Water also filed a copy of its water purchase agreement with WMU. This agreement states that Boonesboro Water

will be treated the same as all other customers of WMU and will receive its proportional share of water from WMU during shortages.

The Commission, having reviewed the application and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that Boonesboro Water, when considering the water storage available from its supplier, is in compliance with the requirements of Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 5(4). As such no deviation is required.


