## ORDER

This matter arising upon petition of South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") filed April 26, 1991 pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, and KRS 61.878, for confidential protection of the cost support data developed by South Central Bell in connection with a Special Service Arrangement Contract for Alliant Health Systems for ESSX Features associated with electronic business sets on the grounds that disclosure of the information is likely to cause South Central Bell competitive injury, and it appearing to this Commission as follows:

South Central Bell has entered into a contract with Alliant Health Systems for the provision of ESSX Features associated with electronic business sets. The information sought to be protected is not known outside of South Central Bell and is not disseminated within South Central Bell except to those employees who have a legitimate business need to know and act upon the information. South Central Bell seeks to preserve the confidentiality of the information through all appropriated means, including the maintenance of appropriate security at its offices.

Section 807 KAR 5:001, 7, protects information as confidential when it is established that disclosure is likely to cause substantial competitive harm to the party from whom the information was obtained. In order to satisfy this test, the party claiming confidentiality must demonstrate actual competition and а likelihood of substantial competitive injury if the information is disclosed. Competitive injury occurs when disclosure of the information gives competitors an unfair business advantage.

South Central Bell's competitors for ESSX service are providers of PBX equipment. Virtually every PBX manufactured today provides similar type feature capability. Disclosure of the information would give providers of PBX equipment who compete with South Central Bell an unfair business advantage in that they could determine South Central Bell's costs and contribution from the service. This information could be used by such competitors to market their competitive service to the detriment of South Central Bell. Therefore, the information should be protected as confidential.

This Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS ORDERED that the cost support data developed by South Central Bell in connection with its Special Service Arrangement Contract for Alliant Health Systems for ESSX Features associated with electronic business sets, which South Central Bell has petitioned be withheld from public disclosure, shall be held and

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retained by this Commission as confidential and shall not be open for public inspection.
