O R D E R

On May 28, 1991, Edmonson County Water District ("Edmonson Water") filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a \$561,000 waterworks improvement project and for approval of its plan of financing for this project. This project will provide service to 185 additional customers. Project funding includes a \$303,000 loan from the Farmers Home Administration ("FmHA"), a \$247,900 Community Development Block Grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"), and \$10,100 from applicants for service in the proposed project area. The loan will be for a 40-year period.

Edmonson Water's application was made pursuant to KRS 278.023 which requires the Commission to accept agreements between water districts and FmHA or HUD and to issue the necessary orders to

implement the terms of such agreements within 30 days of satisfactory completion of the minimum filing requirements. Given that minimum filing requirements were met in this case on June 20, 1991, KRS 278.023 does not grant to the Commission any discretionary authority to modify or reject any portion of this agreement.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Edmonson Water is hereby granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the proposed construction project.
- 2. Edmonson Water's proposed plan of financing with FmHA is accepted.
- 3. Edmonson Water shall file a copy of the "as-built" drawings and a certified statement that the construction has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the contract plans and specifications within 60 days of the substantial completion of the construction certificated herein.
- 4. Edmonson Water shall monitor the adequacies of the expanded water distribution system after construction. If the level of service is inadequate or declining or the pressure to any customer falls outside the requirements of 807 KAR 5:066, Section 6(1), Edmonson Water shall take immediate action to bring the system into compliance with Commission regulations.

Nothing contained herein shall be deemed a warranty of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, or any agency thereof, of the financing herein accepted.
