O R D E R

The Commission, on its own motion, establishes this case to serve as a depository for Reports on Minutes of Use by Service. All intraLATA dominant and non-dominant carriers are required by Administrative Case No. 3231 to file reports on intraLATA minutes of use (Kentucky jurisdictional) by service with this Commission on a quarterly basis. The purpose of these reports is to assist the Commission in evaluating the evolution of the intraLATA toll market. The carriers are directed to file this information in the format presented in Appendix A.

In addition, the Commission finds that interLATA dominant and non-dominant carriers are directed to file reports on interLATA minutes of use (Kentucky-jurisdictional) by service with this Commission on a quarterly basis. This information will be used to evaluate the continuing changes in the interLATA toll market. The carriers are directed to file this information in the format presented in Appendix B.

Administrative Case No. 323, An Inquiry Into IntraLATA Toll Competition, An Appropriate Compensation Scheme for Completion of IntraLATA Calls by Interexchange Carriers, and WATS Jurisdictionality.

The Commission recognizes the sensitive nature of this information in an evolving competitive market and concludes that it meets the criteria of the Open Records Act and is entitled to confidential protection on a continuing basis unless, or until, the Commission should order differently.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. All intraLATA dominant and non-dominant carriers shall file Minutes of Use Reports by Service in the format described in Appendix A on a quarterly basis.
- 2. All interLATA dominant and non-dominant carriers shall file Minutes of Use Reports by Service in the format presented in Appendix B on a quarterly basis.
- 3. The first Minutes of Use Reports by Service shall be due 45 days after the 3rd quarter which shall be defined as July 1, 1991 through September 30, 1991. All subsequent reports shall be due 45 days after the end of each calendar quarter.
- 4. The IntraLATA and InterLATA Minutes of Use Reports by Service filed in the above-styled case shall be held and retained by the Commission as confidential and shall not be open for public inspection.
