## ORDER

Having been advised that Boone County Water and Sewer District ("Boone District") is charging and collecting compensation for services not prescribed in its filed rate schedules and that these unprescribed fees are for services other than sewer tap-ins, the Commission finds that further inquiry into Boone District's fees and rates for sewer services is required.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Boone District shall file an original and 10 copies of the following information with the Commission with a copy to all parties of record within 10 days of the date of this Order. 1. State all fees charged by Boone District which are related to the provision of sewer service. ("Sewer Service" includes the collection and transportation of sewage.)

For each fee listed in Boone District's Response to Item
state:

a. the date when first assessed;

b. whether such fee is set forth in Boone District's filed rate schedules.

3. For each fee which is listed in Boone District's Response to Item 1 and not set forth in Boone District's filed rate schedules:

a. state the reason for its exclusion from Boone District's filed rate schedules;

b. state the total amount collected since its inception;

c. explain how the amount of this fee was determined. Show all calculations and state all assumptions used to arrive at this amount.
