1. A hearing on the proposed Fort Wright, Kentucky cell site be and it hereby is scheduled on October 21, 1991 at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky.


2. Southern Ohio Telephone Company, d/b/a Cellular One, shall appear at the hearing and present testimony on the engineering design, location, and construction of the cell site, and the health and safety issues relating to the operation of the cell site.

3. Any interested person shall have the opportunity to present testimony or comment on any aspect of the proposed cell site, including local issues such as impact on property values.

4. Pursuant to KRS 100.324, a copy of this Order is being sent to the Kenton County Municipal Planning and Zoning Commission, the planning commission of the planning unit of Fort Wright, for the purpose of notification that the above-scheduled hearing may effect locations or relocations of service facilities within the planning unit's jurisdiction.
