O R D E R

On September 3, 1991, the Commission received a complaint from Long Distance Management, a division of Wright Businesses, Inc. ("LDM"), and TMC of Southern Kentucky ("TMC"), petitioners, against South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell"). The Commission required South Central Bell to satisfy or answer the complaint. South Central Bell's answer was received September 30, 1991. South Central Bell moved the Commission to dismiss the complaint.

The Commission, having been otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that, within 20 days of the date of this Order, South Central Bell shall file a memorandum in support of its request to dismiss this complaint, and LDM and TMC shall respond to South Central Bell's memorandum 20 days thereafter.
