
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
On September 26, 1991, Ledbetter Water District ("Ledbetter") filed with the Commission its revised tariff. The revised tariff included special charges previously authorized by the Commission, as well as new special charges not authorized by the Commission. Ledbetter was informed by the Commission on two occasions of specific filing deficiencies which prevented the Commission from processing their application. On November 18, 1991, Ledbetter filed a response stating it wished to withdraw its revised tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this proceeding is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
