O R D E R

The Commission, having been advised of the intention of North East Gas Company ("North East") to discontinue gas service to certain customers, see Exhibit A, finds that an investigation should be initiated into the proposed discontinuance of gas service.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. North East shall not take any action which would result in the discontinuance of gas service to the customers affected until the Commission has issued a final Order in this proceeding.

2. North East shall appear at an informal conference to be held on November 14, 1991 at 10 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, in Conference Room 2 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky, to answer questions concerning the proposed discontinuance of service.

3. North East shall, within 3 days of the date of this Order, serve written notice upon each customer affected by the proposed abandonment of facilities of the initiation of this investigation and that no discontinuance of service shall take place until the investigation has been concluded.



Clatis Walker is made a full intervenor in this proceeding and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence and all other documents submitted by the parties. Should Mr. Walker file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, he shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.

5. Exhibit A is made a part of the record of this proceeding.
