ORDER

On October 18, 1991, Boone County Water and Sewer District ("Boone District") filed a proposed tariff establishing a sewer inspection fee and conditions of service for all customers.

Based upon its review of the proposed tariff and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the proposed sewer inspection fee is reasonable and should be permitted to become effective. The Commission further finds that further proceedings are necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed conditions of service and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Boone District's proposed sewer inspection fee set forth in its tariff P.S.C. No. 1, Original Sheet No. 26, shall become effective for service rendered on and after November 20, 1991.
- 2. The other provision of Boone District's proposed tariff P.S.C. No. 1, Original Sheet No. 25, entitled "Conditions of Service," is suspended pursuant to KRS 278.190(2) up to and including April 19, 1992.
