O R D E R

On April 17, 1991, TMC of Lexington filed a proposed tariff to become effective on and after May 15, 1991.

The Commission finds that:

(1) Since the proposed tariff was filed on April 17, 1991, it should be noticed to be effective on May 17, 1991, which is 30 days from receipt of the application.

(2) Pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff and such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

(1) The proposed tariff be and it hereby is suspended for 5 months from the actual effective date, through October 16, 1991.

(2) Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
