O R D E R

On December 18, 1991, the Commission entered an Order which prohibited dedicated access lines for WATS service and required that Universal WATS Access Lines ("UWALS") be offered. On January 15, 1992, South Central Bell Telephone Company, Inc. ("SCB") filed a motion requesting the Commission reconsider its December 18, 1991 Order and permit customers to choose either a line dedicated for intrastate usage only or a line that would service both inter- and intrastate.

The Commission will grant the motion for reconsideration and finds that an informal conference with SCB, Commission Staff, and any other interested parties should be held to gather additional information prior to a final decision.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. SCB's motion for the Commission to reconsider its December 18, 1991 Order be and is hereby approved to the extent the Commission after an informal conference will again consider its final Order.

2. An informal conference is hereby scheduled for February 21, 1992, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, in Conference Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky, for the purpose of discussing SCB's request to provide intrastate only WATS access lines.
