ORDER

On August 14, 1992, in Civil Action No. 90-CA-1812, the Court of Appeals affirmed a decision of the Franklin Circuit Court which ordered that the Public Service Commission ("Commission") allow Cumberland Falls Highway Water District ("Cumberland Falls") to collect from its customers the sum of \$4,050.00 each month for a nine-month period for the purpose of paying a debt owed for water purchased from April 8, 1987 to November 8, 1988.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

 Cumberland Falls shall collect from its customers the sum of \$0.66 cents per 1,000 gallons each month for a nine-month period, or until \$36,429 is collected.

2. The rate set out in Appendix A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is the rate approved for service starting with the first billing on or after the date of this Order for nine consecutive months or until a total of \$36,429 is collected.

3. Within 10 days of the date of this Order, Cumberland Falls shall file its revised tariff setting out the rate approved herein. 4. Within 30 days of the date the adjusted rates are placed into effect, Cumberland Falls shall file a copy of the notice to its customers and verification that such notice has been given.

5. Cumberland Falls shall file with the Commission a monthly breakdown of revenues generated by the rate approved herein within 10 days from the time the total revenue granted has been collected.

The following rate is prescribed for the customers in the area served by Cumberland Falls Highway Water District. All other rates and charges not specifically mentioned herein shall remain the same as those in effect under authority of this Commission prior to the effective date of this Order.
