O R D E R

On October 10, 1990, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 90-002 approving certain adjustments and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On May 5, 1992, East Kentucky Utilities, Inc. ("East Kentucky") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas will be increased by its supplier, Kentucky West Virginia Gas Company ("Kentucky West"), effective May 1, 1992, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment ("PGA") clause on file with this Commission.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. East Kentucky's notice of May 5, 1992 set out certain revisions in rates which East Kentucky proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale increase in price from its supplier in the amount of \$24,141 or 22.31 cents per Mcf.

2. Kentucky West filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission for increased rates to become effective May 1, 1992. East Kentucky requested a waiver of the 30-day filing requirement. Pursuant to KRS 278.180, upon East Kentucky's showing of good cause, East Kentucky's request should be granted. The effective date for the increase should be on and after the date of this Order. Kentucky West's rates are subject to refund; hence, East Kentucky's rates should be subject to refund.

3. East Kentucky's adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 90-002 dated October 10, 1990 is fair, just, and reasonable, in the public interest, and should be effective with gas supplied on and after the date of this Order, subject to refund.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates in the Appendix, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved effective with gas supplied on and after the date of this Order, subject to refund.


2. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, East Kentucky shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
