proceeding should be generally continued until Western Rockcastle has satisfactorily demonstrated within 60 days of the date of substantial completion of the proposed construction that these improvements will resolve the pressure problems throughout the distribution system. Western Rockcastle shall contract with its engineer to file a signed statement and duly verified pressure records which show the distribution system meets the systems standard pressure range.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. This case be and it hereby is continued.
2. Western Rockcastle shall contract with its engineer to provide a copy of pressure records and a signed statement that all improvements have been completed and the pressure problems have been resolved throughout the system.
3. Western Rockcastle shall file a copy of the above information within 60 days of the date of project completion.
