ORDER

Pursuant to Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission on June 29, 1992 established this case to review and evaluate the operation of the fuel adjustment clause ("FAC") of Jackson County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Jackson County") for the 6 months ended April 30, 1992.

As a part of this review, the Commission ordered Jackson County to submit certain information and an affidavit attesting to its compliance with Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:056. Jackson County has complied with this Order. The Commission further ordered that a public hearing be held in this case but cancelled it when, after publication of notice, no interested party advised the Commission of its intention to attend.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that Jackson County has complied in all material respects with the provisions of Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:056.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the charges and credits applied by Jackson County through its FAC for the period November 1, 1991 through April 30, 1992 be and they hereby are approved.
