ORDER

On September 30, 1991, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 90-402 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On February 11, 1992, Martin Gas, Inc. ("Martin") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas had been decreased by its supplier, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. ("Columbia"), effective March 1, 1992, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Martin's notice of February 11, 1992 set out certain revisions in rates which Martin proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale decrease in price from its supplier in the amount of \$19,277 or 17.19 cents per Mcf. 2. Columbia filed with the Commission for decreased rates to be effective March 1, 1992. The effective date for Martin's decrease should be on and after March 1, 1992.

3. The adjustment in Martin's rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 90-402 dated September 30, 1991 is fair, just, and reasonable, in the public interest, and should be effective with gas supplied on and after March 1, 1992.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates in the Appendix, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved effective with gas supplied on and after March 1, 1992.

2. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Martin shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
