GTE South Incorporated ("GTE South") seeks rehearing of the Commission's Order finding extended area service between Lexington, Midway, and Georgetown to be in the public interest. The Commission received GTE South's petition for rehearing of its November 25, 1991 Order on December 13, 1991. The petition for rehearing raises no new issues which have not been previously considered by the Commission in its determinations and no party has responded to GTE South's petition for rehearing. Accordingly, the petition should be denied.


Having considered GTE South's petition and having been otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

2. The November 25, 1991 Order in this proceeding remains in full force and effect.


