O R D E R


On March 20, 1992, the Commission received a notice from Southern Ohio Telephone Company ("SOTCO") and Larry and Mary Twehues, the Intervenors, stating that a settlement had been executed. The Intervenors requested to withdraw their petition for rehearing and gave consent for re-entry of the Commission's December 6, 1991 Order granting SOTCO a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a tower and related facility as described in the application.

The Commission, having considered this March 20, 1992 notice and having been otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:


1. The Intervenors' request to withdraw their petition for rehearing be and hereby is granted.
2. The December 6, 1991 Order in this proceeding is hereby final.
