ORDER

This matter arising upon motion of South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") filed April 20, 1992 for permission to deviate from the provisions of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7(2)(b), in filing its response to Item 3(a) of the Commission's Order dated November 4, 1991 on the grounds that compliance will cause South Central Bell an undue hardship, and it appearing to this Commission as follows:

On April 9, 1992, the Commission by Order granted confidential protection to South Central Bell's response to Item 3(a) of the Commission's Order of November 4, 1991 and directed South Central Bell to file an edited copy of the information with the confidential material obscured for inclusion in the public record. The information was provided to the Commission on 25 diskettes which if printed would require an estimated 4,000 sheets of paper. Editing sufficient copies of the 4,000 sheets of paper for inclusion in the public record and service upon parties of record would require an enormous effort on the part of South Central Bell and the cost and burden of complying would outweigh any benefits to be derived from compliance with the regulation.

Therefore, South Central Bell should be permitted to deviate from the requirement of the regulation.

This Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS ORDERED that South Central Bell's motion is granted and it shall not be required to file an edited copy of its response to Item 3(a) of the Commission's Order of November 4, 1991.
