O R D E R

On August 14, 1991, WATS/800, Inc. ("WATS/800") filed its application with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate interLATA resold telecommunications services. WATS/800 does not request authority to provide intraLATA or operator-assisted services.

On September 30, 1991, the Commission ordered WATS/800 to file additional information. WATS/800 filed its response on October 25, 1991.

WATS/800 is organized as a corporation in the state of Indiana. The financial, managerial, and technical capabilities of WATS/800 have been demonstrated in the application. WATS/800 does not own and/or operate any facilities in any jurisdiction. WATS/800 will resell tariffed services offered solely by AT&T, specifically, AT&T's Software Defined Network (SDN) and Distributed Network Service (DNS).

The Commission, having considered the application of WATS/800, its supporting exhibits, the information provided by WATS/800 in response to the Commission's Order, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that WATS/800 should be granted authority to provide intrastate interLATA long-distance telecommunications services as a reseller within the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The rates proposed by WATS/800 should be approved as the fair, just, and reasonable rates to be charged by WATS/800.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. WATS/800 be and it hereby is granted authority to provide intrastate interLATA long-distance telecommunications services as a reseller within the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

2. This authority to provide service is strictly limited to those services described in this Order and WATS/800's application.


3. The rates proposed by WATS/800 are hereby approved.


4. Within 30 days from the date of this Order, WATS/800 shall file its tariff sheets pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011 setting out the rates approved herein and all rules governing the provision of service in accordance with the Commission's Orders and administrative regulations.
