O R D E R

On August 21, 1991, The Hogan Company ("Hogan") filed its application with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate interLATA resold telecommunications services. Hogan does not request authority to provide intraLATA or operator-assisted services.

On September 24, 1991, the Commission ordered Hogan to file additional information. Hogan filed its response on October 18, 1991.

Hogan is organized as a corporation in the state of Washington. The financial, managerial, and technical capabilities of Hogan have been demonstrated in the application. Hogan does not own and/or operate any facilities in any jurisdiction. Hogan will resell tariffed services offered solely by MCI and US Sprint.

The Commission, having considered the application of Hogan, its supporting exhibits, the information provided by Hogan in response to the Commission's Order, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that Hogan should be granted authority

to provide intrastate interLATA long-distance telecommunications services as a reseller within the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and that the rates proposed by Hogan should be approved as the fair, just, and reasonable rates to be charged by Hogan.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Hogan be and it hereby is granted authority to provide intrastate interLATA long-distance telecommunications services as a reseller within the Commonwealth of Kentucky.


2. This authority to provide service is strictly limited to those services described in this Order and Hogan's application.

3. The rates proposed by Hogan are hereby approved.


4. Within 30 days from the date of this Order, Hogan shall file its revised tariff sheets pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011 setting out the rates approved herein and all rules governing the provision of service in accordance with the Commission's Orders and administrative regulations.
