O R D E R

On September 9, 1991, Corporate Telemanagement Group, Inc. ("CTG") filed its application with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate interLATA resold telecommunications services. CTG does not request authority to provide intraLATA or operator-assisted services.

On November 15, 1991, the Commission ordered CTG to file additional information. CTG filed its response on December 16, 1991.

CTG is organized as a corporation in the state of South Carolina. The financial, managerial, and technical capabilities of CTG have been demonstrated in the application. CTG does not own and/or operate any facilities in any jurisdiction. CTG will resell tariffed services offered solely by MCI and US Sprint.

The Commission, having considered the application of CTG, its supporting exhibits, the information provided by CTG in response to the Commission's Order, and being otherwise sufficiently

advised, finds that CTG should be granted authority to provide intrastate interLATA long-distance telecommunications services as a reseller within the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and that the rates proposed by CTG should be approved as the fair, just, and reasonable rates to be charged by CTG.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. CTG be and it hereby is granted authority to provide intrastate interLATA long-distance telecommunications services as a reseller within the Commonwealth of Kentucky.


2. This authority to provide service is strictly limited to those services described in this Order and CTG's application.

3. The rates proposed by CTG are hereby approved.


4. Within 30 days from the date of this Order, CTG shall file its revised tariff sheets pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011 setting out the rates approved herein and all rules governing the provision of service in accordance with the Commission's Orders and administrative regulations.
