ORDER

On December 3, 1991, Affinity, Fund Inc. ("Affinity") filed its application with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate, long-distance telecommunications services as a reseller within the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Affinity, a Florida Corporation, with its principal offices located in the State of Wisconsin, is proposing to resell tariffed services of facility-based carriers certified by the Commission. Affinity is not seeking authority to provide operator-assisted telecommunications services.

Affinity owns no transmission or reception telecommunications equipment or facilities. In the performance of its services, all operating facilities, equipment and networking will be provided by the underlying carrier. Affinity will not construct any new facilities in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

In Affinity's January 28, 1992 response to the Commission's January 13, 1992 Order, it informed the Commission that money had been collected for non-certified service. This violation was

resolved in Case No. 92-0691 by Commission Order dated August 27, 1992.

The application provided by Affinity demonstrates its financial, managerial, and technical capability. The rates proposed should be approved as the fair, just and reasonable rates to be charged.

The Commission, having considered the application, the information provided by Affinity, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 1. Affinity be and it hereby is granted authority to provide intrastate, long-distance telecommunications within the Commonwealth of Kentucky on and after the date of this Order.
- 2. Affinity's authority to provide service in this Commonwealth is strictly limited to those services described in this Order and Affinity's application.
- 3. The rates and charges proposed by Affinity are hereby approved, as filed on December 3, 1991 and revised on January 28, 1992.
- 4. Within 30 days from the date of this Order, Affinity shall file its December 3, 1991 and revised January 28, 1992 tariff sheets without modifications in accordance with 807 KAR 5:011 to conform to the restrictions and conditions of service contained herein.
