O R D E R

On December 16, 1991, Princeton Telecommunications Corp. ("Princeton") filed its application with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to resell intrastate long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Princeton proposes to resell US Sprint Dial 1 WATS and FonLine 800 services as set forth in Sprint's tariff on file with the Commission. Princeton is not seeking authority to provide any operator-assisted telecommunications or payphone services.

Princeton employs no transmission or reception telecommunications equipment or facilities in the performance of its services. All operating facilities, equipment, and networking will continue to be provided by the underlying carrier. However, Princeton shall sell and provide order processing, while producing through its contractor, Compucom, a monthly direct bill to end-users based on Princeton's tariffed rates.

The financial, managerial, and technical capabilities of Princeton are demonstrated in the application provided by Princeton. The rates proposed by Princeton should be approved as the fair, just, and reasonable rates to be charged.

The Commission, having considered the application, the information provided by Princeton, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Princeton be and it hereby is granted authority to resell telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky on and after the date of this Order.

2. Princeton shall comply with the Commission's Orders in Administrative Case No. 323.<sup>1</sup>

3. Princeton's authority to provide service in this Commonwealth is strictly limited to those services described in this Order and Princeton's application.

4. The rates proposed by Princeton are hereby approved.


5. Within 30 days from the date of this Order, Princeton shall file its tariff sheets pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011, setting out the rates approved herein and rules governing the provision of service in accordance with the Commission's Orders and Administrative Regulations.

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
