O R D E R

On February 7, 1992, South Central Bell Telephone Company of Kentucky ("South Central Bell") filed with the Commission a proposed tariff to establish Customer List Services. The proposed tariff would make customer lists available to interexchange carriers for the purpose of assisting them in marketing efforts connected with subscriptions and marketing of interexchange telecommunications services.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rates and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The proposed rates are hereby suspended for 5 months from March 9, 1992 up to and including August 8, 1992.
2. The proposed tariff pages to be suspended are as follows:


