ORDER

Taylor County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Taylor County") has moved for leave to amend and supplement its application. In support of its motion, Taylor County states that it recently discovered that East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC"), its power supplier, had erroneously underbilled it for purchased power during the test period. Taylor County further states that, had the correct level of purchased power expense been known at the filing of its application, Taylor County would have sought rates and charges which would have produced additional annual revenues of \$1,111,943, instead of the requested amount of \$785,568.

Having reviewed Taylor County's motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that good cause exists to grant the motion. The Commission advises Taylor County that the proposed amendment to its application requires the issuance of new notice to the Commission in the form of revised tariff sheets containing the amended rates and stating an effective date of June 25, 1992 and to its customers in the form prescribed by Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Taylor County's motion to amend and supplement its application is granted.

2. Taylor County shall submit its amended application within 5 days of the date of this Order.

3. In amending its application, Taylor County shall strictly comply with the provisions of KRS 278.180 and Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8.

4. Taylor County shall, at the time of filing its amended application, submit amended responses to the Commission's Orders of March 31, 1992 and June 5, 1992 which are affected by the amendments to its original application.
