## ORDER

("Consolidated") shall file an original and one copy of responses to the information requested herein to all parties of record within 10 days of the date of this Order. If the information cannot be provided by this date, Consolidated should submit a motion for an extension of time stating the reason a delay is necessary and include a date by which it will be furnished. Such motion will be considered by the Commission.

1. Test-year (calendar-year 1991) payments to Owensboro Country Club ("OCC") totaled \$2,796 of which \$1,570 represented membership dues. Consolidated proposed to exclude, for rate-making purposes, \$1,560 which had been charged to Account No. 426 -- Miscellaneous Income Deductions. To which account were test-year payments to OCC over and above the \$1,560 charged?

- 2. Explain the benefit accruing to Consolidated's customers of payments to OCC for food and bar expenses, cart usage and greens fees, and golf pro-shop expenses.
- 3. Provide a breakdown of test-year charges of \$4,900 to Account No. 930 -- Miscellaneous General Expenses.
- 4. Provide copies of any invoices for rate-case expenses actually incurred to date.
