O R D E R

On March 9, 1992, Green-Taylor Water District ("Green-Taylor") filed its revised tariff with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") for the purpose of adjusting its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068.

The Commission, having reviewed the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. Green-Taylor purchases water from Green River Valley Water District ("Green River") and the city of Greensburg ("Greensburg").

2. Effective March 1, 1992, Green River increased its rate for wholesale water from \$.90 to \$1.10 per 1,000 gallons. Effective with the bill rendered March 1, 1992, Greensburg increased its rate for wholesale water from \$1.0699 to \$1.37 per 1,000 gallons.

3. Green-Taylor proposed to increase the rates to its customers effective April 1, 1992. Based on average monthly usage of 5,000 gallons, the monthly bill for Green-Taylor's customers

will increase \$1.80 from \$26.25 to \$28.05, an increase of 6.9 percent.

4. During the 12 months ending January 31, 1992, Green-Taylor purchased 202,670,100 gallons of water, of which 40,005,100 gallons were purchased from Green River and 162,665,000 gallons from Greensburg.

5. Green-Taylor sold 155,753,600 gallons during the same 12-month period.

6. The increase in purchased water costs is \$56,817, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of \$.36 per 1,000 gallons.

7. The purchased water adjustment of 36 cents per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved.

8. The proposed tariff filed by Green-Taylor is correct and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. The purchased water adjustment of 36 cents per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A are hereby approved for services rendered on and after April 1, 1992.

2. The proposed tariff filed by Green-Taylor is approved, effective April 1, 1992.


3. On or before April 1, 1992, Green-Taylor shall file a copy of the notice to its customers and verification that such notice has been given.

APPENDIX A

APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 92-088 DATED 3/24/92

The following rates and charges are prescribed for the customers in the area served by Green-Taylor Water District. All other rates and charges not specifically mentioned herein shall remain the same as those in effect under authority of this Commission prior to the effective date of this Order.

Monthly Rates

5/8 x 3/4 Inch Connections

First 2,000 gallons	\$12.96 Minimum Bill
Next 4,000 gallons	5.03 per 1,000 gallons
Next 19,000 gallons	3.83 per 1,000 gallons
Over 25,000 gallons	2.28 per 1,000 gallons

3/4 Inch Connections

First 6,000 gallons	\$33.08 Minimum Bill
Next 19,000 gallons	3.83 per 1,000 gallons
Over 25,000 gallons	2.28 per 1,000 gallons

1 Inch Connections

First 10,000 gallons	\$48.40 Minimum Bill
Next 15,000 gallons	3.83 per 1,000 gallons
Over 25,000 gallons	2.28 per 1,000 gallons

1 1/2 Inch Connections

First 25,000 gallons	\$105.85 Minimum Bill
Over 25,000 gallons	2.28 per 1,000 gallons

2 Inch Connections

First 40,000 gallons	\$140.05 Minimum Bill
Over 40,000 gallons	2.28 per 1,000 gallons

Meter Rates for Trailer Parks

The minimum bill shall be based on the regular residential minimum, including the minimum gallonage, multiplied by the trailer park capacity and divided by two. Usage thereafter shall be billed on regular rates.
