ORDER

On March 5, 1992, Independent Cellular Network ("Independent Cellular") filed with the Commission a revision to its current tariff. In its filing, Independent Cellular requested a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 6, on the grounds that existing customers will not be affected.

807 KAR 5:011, Section 6, requires that the Commission and the public be given at least 30 days' notice before a tariff becomes effective. Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Independent Cellular's request to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 6, should be denied. As the information required by the regulation cited above has not been filed with Independent Cellular's proposed tariff, the Commission further finds its tariff cannot be adequately reviewed prior to the proposed effective date of April 8, 1992. Accordingly, the filing must be suspended.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Independent Cellular's request for a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 6, be and it hereby is denied.
- 2. Independent Cellular shall publish notice and shall furnish verification of such notice to the Commission.
- 3. Independent Cellular's proposed tariff in this matter be and it hereby is suspended for five months from the proposed effective date of April 8, 1992, up to and including September 7, 1992. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
