## ORDER

On March 12, 1992, Amerishare Communications, Inc. ("Amerishare") filed its application with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate, long-distance telecommunications services as a reseller within the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Amerishare is a Florida Corporation proposing to resell AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc. ("AT&T") tariffed services. AT&T provides all originating and terminating transmission facilities in conjunction with local exchange companies providing local access. AT&T also provides switching functions, collects call detail information regarding each call, and bills end-users. Amerishare will not provide any operator services or construct any facilities in Kentucky.

The application provided by Amerishare demonstrates its financial, managerial, and technical capability. The rates proposed should be approved as the fair, just, and reasonable rates to be charged. The Commission, having considered the application, the information provided by Amerishare, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Amerishare be and it hereby is granted authority to provide intrastate, long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth on and after the date of this Order.

2. Amerishare shall comply with the provisions of the Order in Administrative Case No. 323.<sup>1</sup>

3. The rates proposed by Amerishare are hereby approved.

4. Within 30 days from the date of this Order, Amerishare shall file its tariff sheets pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011, setting out the rates approved herein.
