O R D E R

Lexington-South Elkhorn Water District ("South Elkhorn") filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to upgrade its existing system and to finance on April 30, 1992. South Elkhorn also submitted an application for authority to generally adjust its rates on July 17, 1992.

A preliminary review of each application indicates that there are questions of law and fact common to both, and that their consolidation will avoid the needless duplication of administrative proceedings and unnecessary costs and delay. Accordingly, the Commission finds it to be more expedient to consolidate both applications into one proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. Case No. 92-099 and South Elkhorn's application for authority to generally adjust its rates are hereby consolidated.
