ORDER

On March 20, 1992, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("East Kentucky") filed an application for authority to construct 300 MW of combustion turbine peaking capacity. The application also requested a deviation, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14, of the requirement, set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(b), that such an application include copies of governmental permits for the proposed new construction. As grounds for its request East Kentucky stated that although the governmental permits have not yet been issued, it was necessary to file the construction application with the Commission to ensure that there is sufficient time to investigate and adjudicate the application.

Based on East Kentucky's request and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds good cause to grant a deviation to the extent that the governmental permits should be filed within 10 days of their receipt by East Kentucky.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. East Kentucky be and it hereby is granted a deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(b), to the extent that governmental permits shall be filed within 10 days of their receipt.
- 2. Motions for extension of time with respect to the schedule established by the Commission's April 16, 1992 Order shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of compelling reasons.
- 3. All requests for information and responses thereto shall be appropriately indexed and 12 copies shall be filed with the Commission, with copies to all parties of record. All responses shall include the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.
- 4. East Kentucky shall give notice of the hearing to the Planning Commission of any planning unit (as those terms are defined in KRS 100.111) having jurisdiction in the area that facilities are proposed to be constructed.
- 5. East Kentucky shall give notice of the hearing to the public pursuant to KRS 278.025(5) and 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8(5).
- 6. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further orders in this matter.
