## ORDER

On March 30, 1992, the Commission received an application from American Automated Telecom, Inc. ("American Automated Telecom") for authority to operate as a reseller within Kentucky. On April 15, 1992, the Commission Staff notified American Automated Telecom, by letter, that its application was rejected based on filing deficiencies. American Automated Telecom was granted 15 days in which to cure the filing deficiencies. On May 7, 1992, a letter of reminder granting 15 additional days to correct the filing deficiencies was sent to American Automated Telecom. No response has been received and the deficiencies of the original application have not been cured.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case be dismissed without prejudice to American Automated Telecom to reapply.
