## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that OCOM Corporation ("OCOM") shall file the original and ten copies of the following information with the Commission. The information requested shall be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed.

The information requested herein is due no later than 30 days from the date of this Order. If the information cannot be provided by this date, OCOM shall submit a motion for an extension of time stating the reason a delay is necessary and include a date by which it can be furnished. Such motion will be considered by the Commission.

1. Refer to Section 3.9 of the proposed tariff. Provide a revised tariff sheet setting out in detail the criteria to be considered in determining whether a customer will be required to make a deposit.

2. Refer to Section 3.11. Provide a revised tariff sheet showing termination notice requirements and conditions of termination in compliance with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 14. 3. Refer to Original Sheet No. 23. Add the following language at the end of Section 3:

Acceptance by the Commission of the liability provisions contained in this tariff does not constitute its determination that the limitation of liability imposed by the company should be upheld in a court of law, but the recognition that, as it is the duty of the courts to adjudicate negligence claims and rights to recover damages therefor, so it is the duty of the courts to determine the validity of the exculpatory provisions of this tariff.

4. Refer to Section 4.1. Explain in detail the other dialing patterns which may be used.

5. Has OCOM or any of its affiliates ever provided and/or collected any money from the public for the provision of intrastate telecommunications services in Kentucky? If so, explain in detail.

6. Does OCOM own and/or operate any coin-operated telephones in any jurisdiction? If so, explain.

7. Does OCOM have any affiliation with any other company which owns and/or operates any coin-operated telephones in any jurisdiction? If so, explain.
