ORDER

On March 24, 1992, South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") filed a proposed tariff to introduce an outward intraLATA toll Optional Calling Plan entitled WatsSaver and to restructure the existing WATS and 800 service rate schedule and billing procedures. South Central Bell proposed an effective date for WatsSaver of April 23, 1992 and a proposed effective date of May 1, 1992 for the WATS and 800 service restructure.

After review, the Commission finds that the tariff filing should be approved. The Commission will require South Central Bell to file within 15 months from the date of this Order, its actual sales volumes, billing procedures, the actual embedded and incremental costs associated with each service and revenues for the first 12 month period of operation for WATS and WatsSaver.

Within 30 months from the date of this Order South Central Bell should file the same information for the second year of operation for restructured WATS and WatsSaver.

The Commission, having been sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 1. South Central Bell's tariff for the provision of WatsSaver and the restructure of existing WATS and 800 service is approved, subject to the provisions of ordering paragraphs 2 and 3 herein.
- Within 15 months from the date of this Order, South Central Bell shall file its actual sales volumes, billing procedures, the actual embedded and incremental costs associated with each service and revenues received for the first 12 month period of operation for WATS and WatsSaver.
- 3. Within 30 months from the date of this Order, South Bell shall file its actual sales volumes, billing procedures, actual embedded and incremental costs associated with each service and revenues for the second year of operation for WATS and WatsSaver.
