
The purpose of this letter is to inform the Public Service Commission that the City of St. Matthews is in opposition to Case # 92-176.

The construction of this tower adjacent to an established residential neighborhood is an intrusion that violates the guidelines of our community's land use legislation.

It is apparent to the City Council and to property owners in the immediate area of the proposed tower and the existing Bell South tower that the neighborhood character is adversely impacted. The existing tower along with the second structure will further deteriorate the residential neighborhood character.
