## ORDER

This matter arising upon petition of Telecom\*U.S.A. filed May 11, 1992 pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, for confidential protection of Attachment No. 1 to its 1991 Annual Report on the grounds that disclosure of the information is likely to cause Telecom\*U.S.A. competitive injury, and it appearing to this Commission as follows:

Telecom\*U.S.A. has petitioned the Commission to withhold as confidential Attachment No. 1 to its 1991 Annual Report. The attachment was filed with the petition, but an edited copy obscuring the information sought to be protected was not filed as required by the regulation. Therefore, the petition is not sufficient and cannot be granted.

This Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The petition to protect as confidential Attachment No. 1 to Telecom\*U.S.A.'s 1991 Annual Report be and is hereby denied.

2. The information sought to be protected shall be held and retained by this Commission as confidential and shall not be open for public inspection for a period of 20 days from the date of this Order to allow Telecom\*U.S.A. an opportunity to file a supplemental petition in accordance with the procedure set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7.

3. If at the expiration of the 20-day period Telecom\*U.S.A. has not filed a petition in accordance with the regulation, the information shall be placed in the public record without further Order of the Commission.
