If information cannot be provided within this Kentucky-American should submit a motion for an extension of time stating the reason a delay is necessary and include a date by which it will be furnished. Such motion will be considered by the Commission. Kentucky-American shall furnish with each response the name of the witness who will be available for responding to questions concerning each item of information requested in the event a public hearing is necessary.

2. Explain why Jacqueline Henderson requested to have a

meter set and the water turned on at 1078 Redwood Drive on October

3. Did Jacqueline Henderson reside at 1078 Redwood Drive

when she requested the meter and turn-on? If not, why was she

allowed to request this?

4. Why did Jacqueline Henderson request the water to be

shut off on November 4, 1991, only 5 days after the meter was

turned on?

5. Explain why the shut-off order for 1078 Redwood Drive

dated November 4, 1991 was requested by Jacqueline Henderson,

whose billing address is listed as 1825 Gerald Drive #D.

6. Describe the dwelling located at 1078 Redwood Drive

(i.e. number of bedrooms, bathrooms, etc.).

7. Was an illegal meter turn tool found by a

Kentucky-American employee at 1078 Redwood Drive during any of the

listed service visits? If yes, was any further investigation

conducted?
