- 1. Has NOS Communications ever provided and/or collected any money from the public for the provision of intrastate telecommunications services in the Commonwealth of Kentucky? If so, explain in detail.
- 2. Does NOS Communications, or any affiliate, own and/or operate any transmission facilities in any jurisdiction?

3. Does NOS Communications intend to be associated in any way with the provision of payphone service within the Commonwealth of Kentucky?

4. Does NOS Communications intend to provide operatorassisted services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky?

5. Provide a toll-free number or provision for accepting collect calls for customer complaints.
