ORDER

On June 23, 1992, North Shelby Water Company ("North Shelby") filed with the Commission an application to adjust its rates for certain non-recurring charges. On August 4, 1992, North Shelby requested a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10(3), on the grounds that an undue burden would be placed on existing customers if a general rate case was submitted for the adjustment of tap-on fees.

807 KAR 5:011, Section 10(3), requires that if two similar tariff filings have been made since its last general rate case, that the current application is to be treated as an application for a general rate adjustment. Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds good cause exists to grant North Shelby's request for a deviation from the above-cited regulation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that North Shelby's request for a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10(3), is hereby granted.
