
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
Woodland Acres Sanitation, Inc. ("Woodland") was to appear at a show cause hearing July 28, 1992 per a Commission Order issued June 29, 1992. Woodland responded to the Commission's show cause Order with a letter explaining that all alleged violations of KRS Chapter 278 and 807 KAR 5:071, Section 7(1), had been cured. Commission Staff reinspected the utility for compliance with the applicable statutes and regulations and prepared an inspection report dated August 7, 1992. Staff found that the major deficiencies had been cured but requested Woodland correct several minor deficiencies and inform the Commission when the corrections were completed. The Commission received Woodland's letter September 10, 1992 which indicates Woodland has corrected the remaining minor deficiencies in compliance with the Commission's request. Commission Staff will reinspect Woodland during its regularly scheduled inspection.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case is hereby closed.
