O R D E R

On June 15, 1992, South Central Bell Telephone Company ("SCB") filed a revision to its General Subscribers Services Tariff which proposed to grandfather its Information Delivery Service (976 Service). On July 13, 1992, Winn Communications, Inc. ("Winn Communications") filed its objection to the proposed tariff revision requesting that the proposed tariff revision be suspended for five months until Winn Communications could fully analyze the impact of the revision on its business. The proposed tariff was suspended by Commission Order until December 12, 1992 and Winn Communications was granted full intervention rights in this proceeding.

The Commission, having been advised of Winn Communications' objection to the proposed tariff revision, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Winn Communications shall file with the Commission no later than September 25, 1992, a detailed description of the Information Delivery Services it currently receives and the reasons why it will be adversely affected by SCB's proposed tariff revision.

2. SCB shall respond to or satisfy Winn Communications' complaint regarding the proposed tariff revision no later than October 9, 1992.
